Local Outreach 2016

Supported Organizations

ACT (Abuse Counseling and Treatment)

Serving victims of domestic violence, sexual assault and human trafficking. Available opportunities include the Second Act Thrift Store, the ACT hotline, administration, and outreach programs.

Bright Beginnings

An early-childhood ministry of CLUMC, the preschool welcomes volunteers in classrooms and for special activities.

Children's Network of Southwest Florida

This nonprofit organization is responsible for the child welfare system in the five-county area, working with the community to protect children and preserve families. The Network works with over 1,400 children and their families, delivering care through more than 50 social service agencies.

The Clothes Closet at Faith UMC

The Clothes Closet provides new and gently worn clothing, shoes and accessories to those in need. Volunteers sort clothing on Thursday and Saturday mornings, and distribute clothing Tuesday mornings and Thursday afternoons.

Dunbar High School Girls Basketball

Church members can support the team with financial contributions that help purchase needed equipment, as well as by attending games and helping with gate receipts or concession stand sales.

Ft. Myers Rescue Mission

The mission in downtown Fort Myers serves the homeless, housing 65 men and feeding 300-500 people daily.

Gladiolus Learning & Development Center

The center provides educational and developmental child care for 200 children of low income working families and strives to provide for the social, emotional, economic, and the developmental needs of those children and families.



The Heights Center/ Heights Foundation

The Heights Foundation works to build strong, self-sufficient families in the Harlem Heights neighborhood. Volunteers are needed for special community outreach events as well as tutoring and mentoring.

Kairos Prison Ministry

This ministry aims to change hearts and transform lives by sharing God's love, grace, and mercy with the incarcerated as well as their families.

Our Mother's Home

Our Mother's Home transitions teen mothers and their children from foster care and human trafficking to stable, happy, and productive lives. Volunteers are needed for tutoring, mentoring, baby sitting, and group facilitation.

South Fort Myers Food Pantry

The food pantry housed at Cypress Lake Presbyterian Church provides food to those in need within our community and is supported by sixteen local churches. Volunteers unpack, shelve, and distribute food on Monday mornings and evenings.

Tice UMC Food Pantry

Tice UMC, a small sister church in East Ft Myers, serves about 150 families each week with its food pantry ministry. Volunteers bring clean, dry plastic grocery bags donated by our congregation.

Young Life of Lee County

Young Life is a non-denominational, Christian organization committed to impacting kids' lives and preparing them for the future. Young Life introduces adolescents to Jesus Christ and helping them grow in their faith, while providing strong, positive influences in their lives.
