Isaiah 41:10 "Don't worry because I am with you," says God. "Don't be afraid, because I am your God. I will make you strong and I will help you. I will support you."

Isaiah 46:3-5 *Listen. I have upheld you since you were conceived and I have taken care of you from your birth. Even when you are old, I will be the same. Even when your hair has turned gray, I will take care of you. I made you and I will take care of you. I will carry you and save you. Can you compare Me to anyone? No one is equal to Me or like Me.*

Isaiah 40:31 *Those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.*
