Crew Leader for Pre-K-K

Function as guide for a group as they travel together. Greet children as they arrive to the Sanctuary each morning and be with your group. Be aware of children's needs, etc. Help Station Leaders as needed.

Crew Leader for Grades 1-5

Function as guide for a group as they travel together. Greet children as they arrive to the Sanctuary each morning and be with your group. Be aware of children's needs, etc. Help Station Leaders as needed.

Bible Station Leaders

Prepare and supervise daily Bible Station. Use the plans as provided. Work alongside other Station Leaders, Group Leaders, and Pastor Kayln to communicate needs of station as needed.

There will be two separate Bible Stations for PreK-K and Grades 1-5.

Craft Station Leaders

Prepare and supervise daily Bible Station. Use the plans as provided. Work alongside other Station Leaders, Group Leaders, and Pastor Kayln to communicate needs of station as needed.

There will be two separate Craft Stations for PreK-K and Grades 1-5.

Science Station Leaders

Prepare and supervise daily Bible Station. Use the plans as provided. Work alongside other Station Leaders, Group Leaders, and Pastor Kayln to communicate needs of station as needed.

There will be two separate Science Stations for PreK-K and Grades 1-5.

Games Station Leaders

Prepare and supervise daily Bible Station. Use the plans as provided. Work alongside other Station Leaders, Group Leaders, and Pastor Kayln to communicate needs of station as needed.

There will be two separate Game Stations for PreK-K and Grades 1-5.

Snack Station Leaders

This team is essential in preparing the plates for each child and youth/adult leader. They will prepare snacks for each rotation that comes through. This group helps with clean-up of this station.

There will be two separate Science Stations for PreK-K and Grades 1-5.

Check-in/Check-out Leaders (may also be station leaders)

Greet families and children in the Narthex as they come to VBS each morning. Check them in according to check-in procedures, share with them their group name, and direct them where to go in Sanctuary.

Upon end of VBS, help parents check out children. Help make sure children are accounted for and safe.

Opening/Closing Session Helpers (may also be station leaders)

The biggest needs are for individuals willing to watch/learn motions for songs we will be teaching. Grady and his team will be leading music each session, but help is needed with teaching and doing motions.

In addition, help is needed with A/V needs. You will receive the music and choreography ahead of time.

Floaters

Volunteers who will not be present for each day of VBS but would still like to help. Floaters may indicate preference, but priority will be placed on needs of VBS.

Youth Helpers

Youth helpers may sign up for any of the available roles as helpers. Must be with additional adults to satisfy Child Protection Policy and Safe Sanctuary requirements.

Please note that there are many roles available to help with set-up and take-down for VBS. There are ways to help set up that you can do both on campus and at home! If you are interested and able to help with set-up the week before VBS or with take-down Friday afternoon, please specify your interest on your volunteer form!
